

NELSON SAUVIN BIO Origin: New-Zealand

Nelson Sauvin was developed by the *New Zealand Institute for Plant and Food Research* as part of the New Hop Variety Development Programme, and was released in 2000.

It was created from New Zealand Smoothcone and a selected male.

It is an excellent all-rounder, capable of producing both punchy Ales and subtle, bitter Lagers.

Its name comes from the Sauvignon Blanc aromas that it develops and which are very specific to it.
