



TETTNANG(ER) BIO

Origin: Germany

Tettnang is a very well known (and recognised!) hop throughout the world. You can find hops labelled "Tettnang" that have been grown in Switzerland, the USA and even Australia! Beware, however, that some of these foreign varieties are

actually hybrids created from the Fuggle and cannot be considered the original Tettnang;).

Very similar to Saaz, but with a high farnese oil content, it has a subtle and balanced sweet spicy note. Depending on the year and the alphas, it can also be used as a dual hop. You can use it at all stages of your brewing, a cult hop that you must try!
